(Including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes). Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organized and affiliated events. A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3 body protector" with the year 2009, (Purple) or 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on the label. BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are not allowed.

HATS

Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats nos:PAS 015 2011,VG1(BS) EN1384 2017, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELL E2016 onwards, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards, MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted in all classes. Hats should have a plain cover, either Black,Navy Blue, Brown,Grey or Green. Velvet Covers are encouraged. Hat Tagging in BSPS classes is compulsory — we will tag hats at this show if needed.
